- **Page 7- CORRIDOR ETHICS - Students should:**

Have a signed pass in their hand during non-passing times.

Walk at all times.

Keep to the right.

Leave all bags/backpacks in lockers.

Use only assigned lockers.

Open and close lockers quietly.

Speak in a normal tone of voice.

Not hold hands or show undue affection for each other.

Keep moving toward their next period destination.

Go directly to their next class in order not to block hallways.

Use lockers only during class changes, unless special permission has been obtained.

- **Page 09- PERIOD 1**

The school day begins officially at 7:50AM; therefore, any student not seated in their first period class by this time is tardy. Students are to report to Period 1 before the 7:50 tardy bell. Students arriving at school early in the morning are to remain in the cafeteria or auditorium until 7:42 or until the students from the first arriving bus enter the building. After 7:42 AM, or when students arrive from buses, students must remain either at their own locker, in the cafeteria for breakfast, or in their assigned classes.

- **Page 13- CELLPHONES** Upon the first offense, the main office will hold onto the device until the end of the school day. The student will be assigned one (1) after-school detention.
- **Page 15- Courses: NOTE:** No weight will be added to Algebra 1 and Biology 1 starting with the graduating class of 2018

Science labs are given ½ credit as an elective.
